Here you will find information on how to take up more sustainable travel opportunities within your development and within the local area.

As part of Kings Barton, a Travel Plan has been produced which sets out the strategy in helping to encourage and increase the level of sustainable travel, as well as minimising the impact of development traffic on local roads and the environment. By promoting and monitoring the type of travel which takes place by residents, the Travel Plan will look to:

- Increase awareness of the advantages and availability of sustainable / active modes of transport
- To promote health and fitness benefits of active travel to all users
- To introduce a package of physical and management measures that will facilitate travel by sustainable modes
- To reduce unnecessary use of the car for journeys to and from the development by residents

# **Your Development**

Located to the north of Winchester, Kings Barton will provide:

- 2,000 new homes
- A new local centre including a variety of retail and community uses
- A new primary school
- A new Park and Ride

## **Your Local Area**

Kings Barton is located to the north of Winchester City Centre, which is only a 20 minute walk and a 10 minute cycle ride. With a range of retail, leisure, education and employment opportunities you have access to a number of facilities nearby in both the city centre and to the west of Kings Barton.

### **Walking and Cycling**

There are a number of walking and cycling routes located within your development and nearby. Andover Road has a footway on the western side providing a route to Winchester to the south and some of your local services and facilities to the west. There are a number of routes towards the eastern part of Kings Barton which provides a connection to Worthy Road.

Local cycle routes are also available including a 26 mile Winchester route and a 25 mile Sparsholt route. National cycle route 23 is available to the east of Winchester City Centre.





## **Smart Driving**

#### **Car Club**

Car Clubs play an important role in future sustainable transport where in England each Car Club vehicle displaces 9 private cars. Car Clubs allow you to book a dedicated vehicle, drive it to the destination you require and then return it back to the same parking space. Car Club vehicles are available 24/7, 365 days of the year and you only pay for the time and distance travelled!

#### **Kings Barton Car Club**

As part of Kings Barton, a Car Club vehicle has been provided and is available to all residents! CALA Homes will provide 3 years free membership to Co-Wheels and you will also receive £25 worth of drivers credit towards your journeys using the promotion code 'WINCHESTER25'. Your Car Club vehicle is now available and is located on Morse Road in the southern parcel of the development.

#### Car Sharing

Around 2.5 million people share their commutes to work every year in the UK. This removes 1.25 million cars from roads and saves around 1.25 million tonnes of CO2 per year. Car sharing is a great way to reduce the amount of solo car trips on our roads not only for work trips but for all trips.

## **Public Transport**

#### **Bus Travel**

Kings Barton is located nearby to a number of bus stops on Andover Road. From here you have the opportunity to travel on services including:

- 85 (Monday to Sunday) Winchester to Andover
- 86 (Monday to Saturday) Winchester Hatch Warren

Further bus services from the stops on the southern section of Andover Road (Jolly Farmer). From here you can access services:

- 7 (Monday to Saturday) Winchester to Sparsholt
- 64/X (Monday to Sunday) Winchester to Alton
- 68 (Monday to Friday) Salisbury College

From Worthy Road, to the eastern side of the site, there are three additional services including:

- 67 (Monday to Saturday) Winchester to Petersfield
- 95 (Monday and Thursday) Winchester Abbotts Barton East Stratton
- SPRING (Monday to Sunday) Winchester to Springvale

#### Rail Travel

Winchester Railway Station is your closest station and located to the south of Kings Barton. At this station there are 286 cycle spaces and a 411 space car park. From Winchester there are opportunities to travel to London Waterloo, Bournemouth, Portsmouth Harbour and Southampton Central.

### What's Next?

As part of the planning application for the development, a Travel Plan document was prepared which sets out the objectives and benefits of sustainable travel and the overall scheme. This document also sets out the targets and measures which the development will look to achieve over a 10 year monitoring period.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys and multi-modal surveys throughout the monitoring period. These surveys will determine the level of different forms of travel undertaken by residents and will help understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the surveys and the monitoring reports will be uploaded to the Travel Plan website.

As part of the Travel Plan each household is entitled to one travel voucher worth up to £150. With two flexible options available, you have the opportunity to choose an option which would suit you and your household.

#### **Option 1**

- A choice of Stagecoach bus passes with 10% off!
