Welcome to your Travel plan pack

Here you will find information on how to take up more sustainable travel opportunities, both within your development and the local area.

As part of Rivermead Gardens, a Travel Plan has been produced which sets out the strategy in helping to encourage and increase the level of sustainable travel, as well as minimising the impact of development traffic on local roads and the environment. By promoting and monitoring the type of travel which takes place by residents, the Travel Plan will look to:

- Increase awareness of the advantages and availability of sustainable / active modes of transport
- To promote health and fitness benefits of active travel to all users
- To introduce a package of physical and management measures that will facilitate travel by sustainable modes
- To reduce unnecessary use of the car for journeys to and from the site by residents

Here you will find a range of up-to-date information on walking and cycling routes, public transport, and other local opportunities in and around Alton.

Your development

Your local area

Located in the Heart of Alton Town Centre, Rivermead Gardens will provide:

- 220 new homes
- A Community Centre, for new and local residents.
- The opening up of the River Wey walk, creating a landscaped walk from the town centre to King's Pond and beyond, with areas for play.
- A 70-bed Care Home and associated Extra Care living complex of 58 homes.
- The conversion of Culverton House to 5 apartments.



A full local area plan including walking and cycling routes, bus stop locations, schools, shops and leisure facilities can be found within this Travel Plan Pack.

Rivermead Gardens is situated to the east of Alton High Street, just a five minute walk and two minute cycle ride from the development. With a range of retail, leisure, education and employment opportunities, you have access to a number of facilities nearby in both the town centre and further afield.

Walking and cycling

Rivermead Gardens is surrounded by a number of walking and cycling routes, providing access to essential services in the town centre, as well as a range of leisurely local trails for you to take advantage of.

Your development provides direct access to The Wey Walk, a newly established route along the picturesque River Wey, circling King's Pond to the East, and flowing West towards the High Street and Flood Meadows Gateway.

The National Cycle Route 224 also runs directly through central Alton and connects to route 23 to the West. It takes you past farms, woodland and parks, offering splendid views of the Hampshire countryside.



Public transport

Car sharing

Bus travel

Rivermead Gardens is nearby to bus stops on Draymans Way, with further local bus stops found on Alton High Street, Lower Turk Street, Normandy Street and from Sainsburys to the South of Draymans Way.

From Draymans Way, stop D provides access to nine services:

- 9 (Monday to Friday) Alton High Street Manor Estate
- 613, 13 and 13X (Monday to Saturday) Basingstoke Liphook / Haselmere
- 23X (Monday to Saturday) Alton Haselmere
- 37X (School Days Only) Cowplain Alton
- 38 (Monday to Friday) Petersfield Alton
- 64 (7 Days a Week) Winchester Alton
- 65 (Monday to Saturday) Alton Guildford

Rail travel

Alton Railway Station is your closest station and can be found to the north east of the development. At this station there are 60 cycle spaces and a 185 space car park with 4 accessible spaces.

From Alton there are opportunities to travel directly to London Waterloo, with stopping services calling at Farnham, Aldershot, Ash Vale, Brookwood, Woking, West Byfleet and Surbiton.

School travel What's next?

Alton Infant School

Alton Infant School is located to the North of the development on Normandy Street and can be accessed via foot or cycle along the main road, which provides a pelican crossing for safe access opposite the school entrance.

Amery Hill School & Saint Lawrence C of E Primary School

Both Amery Hill School and Saint Lawrence C of E Primary School are located to the North West of the development on adjacent sides of the road on Amery Hill. They can be accessed via foot or cycle, with a direct bus stop just outside.

Anstey Junior School


Anstey Junior School can be found to the North of the development on Eastbrook Road, and can be accessed via foot or cycle, with a direct bus stop on Anstey Road.

Alton College (HSDC)

HSDC Alton can be found to the North of the development on Old Odiham Road and can be accessed via foot or cycle along Edward Road. There is also a direct bus service providing access to the campus.

Eggar's School

Eggar's School is located to the North East of the development on London Road, and is accessible via a pelican crossing. There is also a shared pedestrian / cycle path giving access on London Road to the East and South of the school, with a bus stop on the Southern border.



As part of the planning application for the development, a Travel Plan document was prepared which sets out the objectives and benefits of sustainable travel and the overall scheme. This document also sets out the targets and measures which the development will look to achieve over a 5 year monitoring period.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys and traffic surveys throughout the monitoring period. These surveys will determine the level of different forms of travel undertaken by residents and will help understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.

The results of the surveys and the monitoring reports will be uploaded to the Travel Plan website.

As part of the Travel Plan each household is entitled to a cycle voucher of a value of up to £50.

To obtain your £50 cycle voucher, simply purchase your cycle equipment and email us at rivermeadgardenstpc@i-transport.co.uk and follow the steps below:

- Proof of purchase
- Your plot number and address (this is to ensure one voucher per household)
- Proof of address
- Bank details so we can reimburse you
